Dear Grade 3 students and parents,

It is hard to believe that we have now entered into our final quarter of the academic year at KPIS. A big well done to all of Grade 3 for their commitment to their studies so far and I request one final push until the end of the year!

In language arts we finished our study of Narnia and the children have written fantasy stories of their own drawing on ideas developed through their understanding of the novel. We have this week started to read Charlie and the Chocolate Factory and will use this as a platform for developing reading and writing skills in the final quarter. We will also have an opportunity to design and make our own chocolate bars as a project for this module.

In math we are still working on shape and space and the children have a good understanding about 2d and 3d shapes. We will continue with this topic for another week or so before moving onto our last modules which are learning to tell time as well as data and measurement.

In science we have one topic left to study which is space and we have begun learning about it already. We will do a project on constellations which gives us a great opportunity to use the planetarium. We are also busy planning our science fair experiments. All children know their groups and have decided on an experiment of their choice.

We finished our study of Ayutthaya in social studies and are now learning about the post Ayutthaya period, dating from the period of King Taksin until now. We will time line key events and people in this period of recent history and discover how decisions made influence our lives today.
